2023 Summer Taxes

Thursday September 14, 2023, is the last day to pay 2023 Summer taxes without penalty.

You can pay online at www.genoa.org or at the Township offices either in person or by placing payment in one of our drop boxes (receipt will be mailed). Credit card payments are only available online. Payments must be received in our office no later than 9/14/23. Postmarks are not accepted as payment date. If you previously signed up for our ACH program your payment will be deducted from your account on 9/05/23.

Bulk Item Frequently Asked Questions

- Waste Management will take one bulk item from every household every week.
- These are items that do not fit in your garbage cart. Examples include furniture, TVs, washing machines, etc.

- Excess garbage bags or recycling is not bulk.
- All fabric items must be completely wrapped in plastic.
- Bulk should be placed out the night before your collection day, about 3 feet from your garbage cart.
- Bulk items are collected by a special truck and must stay at the curb. Collection can take up to a week. If no pickup after a week, call the Township. We will contact WM on your behalf.
