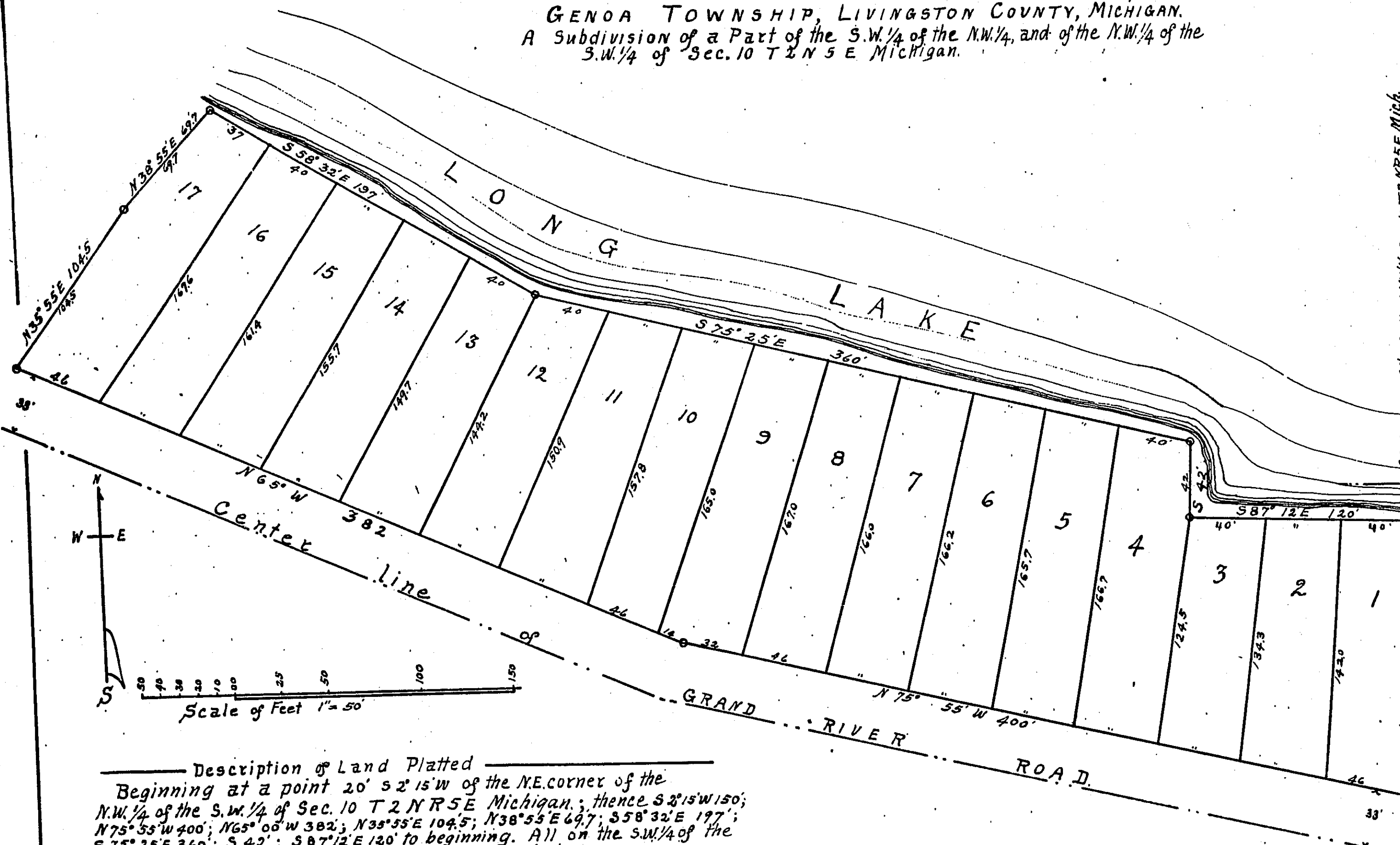


PLAT of GRAND RIVER PARK

Beginning at a point 20' S 2' 15" W of the N.E. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 10 T 2 N R 5 E Michigan; thence S 2' 15" W 150'; N 75° 55' W 400'; N 65° 00' W 302'; N 35° 55' E 104.5'; N 38° 55' E 69.7'; S 58° 32' E 197'; S 75° 25' E 360'; S 42'; S 87° 12' E 120' to beginning. All on the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 & N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 10 T 2 N R 5 E Mich.
