

Election/Voting FAQs

Am I registered to vote?

You can check your voter registration on the Michigan Secretary of State's website at <https://webapps.sos.state.mi.us/mivote/>. Just fill in your name and date of birth.

Where do I obtain a Michigan Voter Registration Application?

If you need to register to vote, click on the link for the Michigan Secretary of State's website at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/registervoter>, or you may come to the Genoa Clerk's office to register to vote.

Where do I vote?

What times are the polls open?

On Election Day, the polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. You may also vote during the Early Voting period, which starts the Saturday, nine days before the election and goes through the Sunday prior to election day. The days and hours for each specific election are listed on our [Elections](#) page.

How do I obtain an Absent Voter ballot?

Applications for voting absentee can be filled out on the Michigan Secretary of State's website at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/avapplication>. You may also come to the Clerk's Office to receive a ballot, or call to have an application mailed to you.

I am an active member of the Armed Services on duty outside of from my place of residence or another eligible civilian voter under the MOVE Act. How do I obtain an Absent Voter ballot?

The federal Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment Act (MOVE Act) and amendments to Michigan election law make voting easier for military and overseas civilian citizens. The law provides Michigan voters covered under the MOVE Act to:

- Obtain a blank Federal Post Card application (FPCA) form via e-mail or fax upon request.
- Obtain an Absent Voter ballot via e-mail or fax upon request.
- Check the status of a requested Absent Voter ballot through an online AV Ballot Tracker.

To learn more about your eligibility, apply for or track the status of your ballot go to FVAP.gov.

Where do I obtain more information on candidates and proposals on my ballot?

Got to the Michigan Voter Information Center website at www.Michigan.gov/vote and type in the requested information. Click on “View My Sample Ballot”.

How do I find out the status of my Absent Voter ballot?

Got to the Michigan Voter Information Center website at www.Michigan.gov/vote and type in the requested information. Your ballot status will display along with other information.
