Genoa Charter Township Clarifies Voting Information for the August Primary Election

Genoa Charter Township has become aware that inaccurate information regarding voting locations and early voting dates has recently been shared publicly. To ensure all voters have accurate information, the Township would like to clarify the following:

Early Voting

Early voting for the August Primary Election begins Saturday, July 25, and continues through Sunday, August 2.

During the early voting period, all Genoa Township voters will vote at the Genoa Township Hall between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Election Day Voting

On Election Day, Tuesday, August 4, 2026, voters will vote at their regular precinct polling locations.

Township Hall is not the Election Day polling location. Voters should report to their designated precinct polling place on Election Day. The precincts will be open for voting from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The precinct locations are as follows:

- Precinct 1 – Cleary University
- Precinct 2 – Three Fires Middle School
- Precinct 3 – Community Bible Church
- Precinct 4 – Brighton Church of the Nazarene
- Precinct 5 – Chilson Hills Baptist Church
- Precinct 6 – Chilson Hills Baptist Church

Voters who are unsure of their precinct or polling location are encouraged to verify their registration and polling place before Election Day by visiting the Michigan Voter Information Center or by contacting the Genoa Township Clerk's Office.

Genoa Township is committed to providing accurate election information so every eligible voter can cast their ballot with confidence. Residents are encouraged to rely on official election information from the Township Clerk's Office and the Michigan Secretary of State when planning to vote.
