Election Information: Deadline to Spoil A Ballot and Receive A New One

Recently candidates have been withdrawing from the August 4th Primary election, whose names are already on the ballot. We have been informed of information being circulated on how you may change your ballot and wish to ensure that you, the voters of Genoa, have the correct information.

If you have voted your ballot and returned it to the Clerk's Office already:

Come into Township Hall and complete a Spoil Ballot/Ballot Reissuance form. This will allow your original ballot to be removed from active and stored for destruction. You will be issued a new ballot that you can vote and turn in at Township Hall or take home and return it later via mail or dropbox.

NOTE: The deadline to be able to receive a new ballot in this scenario is Friday, July 24th by 5:00 p.m.

If you have voted your ballot but have not returned it to the Clerk's Office:

Call the Clerk's Office and request or come into Township Hall and complete a Spoil Ballot/Ballot Reissuance form (bring in your original ballot). You will be issued a new ballot immediately. You may vote it at Township Hall or take home and return it later via mail or dropbox. If the request is not in person a ballot may be mailed to you.

NOTE: The deadline to be able to spoil your ballot in this scenario is Friday, July 31st by 5:00 p.m. (to have it mailed to you) and Monday, August 3rd by 4:00 p.m. to receive it in person.
