Spring Yard Waste Dropoff Dates

Our final free 2023 Spring Yard Waste Collection program has been scheduled for 8-11 a.m. on Saturday, May 20.

Residents may bring their yard waste to the Township Hall parking lot on this date. Branches and similar materials must be in 3 foot long bundles.

Please no plastic bags.

Hartland School Election Information

Hartland Consolidated Schools has scheduled an election for May 2, 2023. Township residents who live in the Hartland school district have been mailed an application for an absent voter ballot and notified of the change to their polling place for this single election.

The Township Hall will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for any person choosing to vote in person. Applications may be returned to the Clerk's office for those choosing to vote absent voter ballot.

Bulk Item Frequently Asked Questions

- Waste Management will take one bulk item from every household every week.
- These are items that do not fit in your garbage cart. Examples furniture, TVs, washing machines, etc.
- Excess garbage bags or recycling is not bulk.
- Fabric items must be completely wrapped in plastic.
- Bulk should be placed out the night before your collection day, about 3 feet from your garbage cart.
- Bulk items are collected by a special truck and must stay at the curb. Collection can take up to a week. If no pickup after a week, call the Township. We will contact WM on your

behalf.
