Welcome to this month's edition of Genoa Township news via email. Here's what's coming up in the Township:

The Survivor Park is Open!

The much-anticipated Survivor Park opened on the Township Hall grounds just before Thanksgiving.

Members of the Howell High School Classes of 2021 and 2022, who raised more than \$462,000 for the all-inclusive playscape, attended along with children, Howell school officials and Township representatives. The Township and playscape designer Michigan Recreational Construction also contributed funds.

The playground is designed to be accessible to children of all abilities. Among the features are a zip line, slide, musical elements, a spinning structure and swings.

2023 Tax Information

The 2023 Summer taxes were due on September 14, 2023. Summer taxes can still be paid at the Township with additional interest now due. If you're not sure if your summer taxes have been paid please check the Township website at www.genoa.org or contact the Treasurer's office at 810-227-5225.

The 2023 Winter taxes were mailed out to all property owners on Thursday, November 30, 2023, and are payable thru February 29, 2024.

Bulk Item Disposal and Xmas Tree FAQ

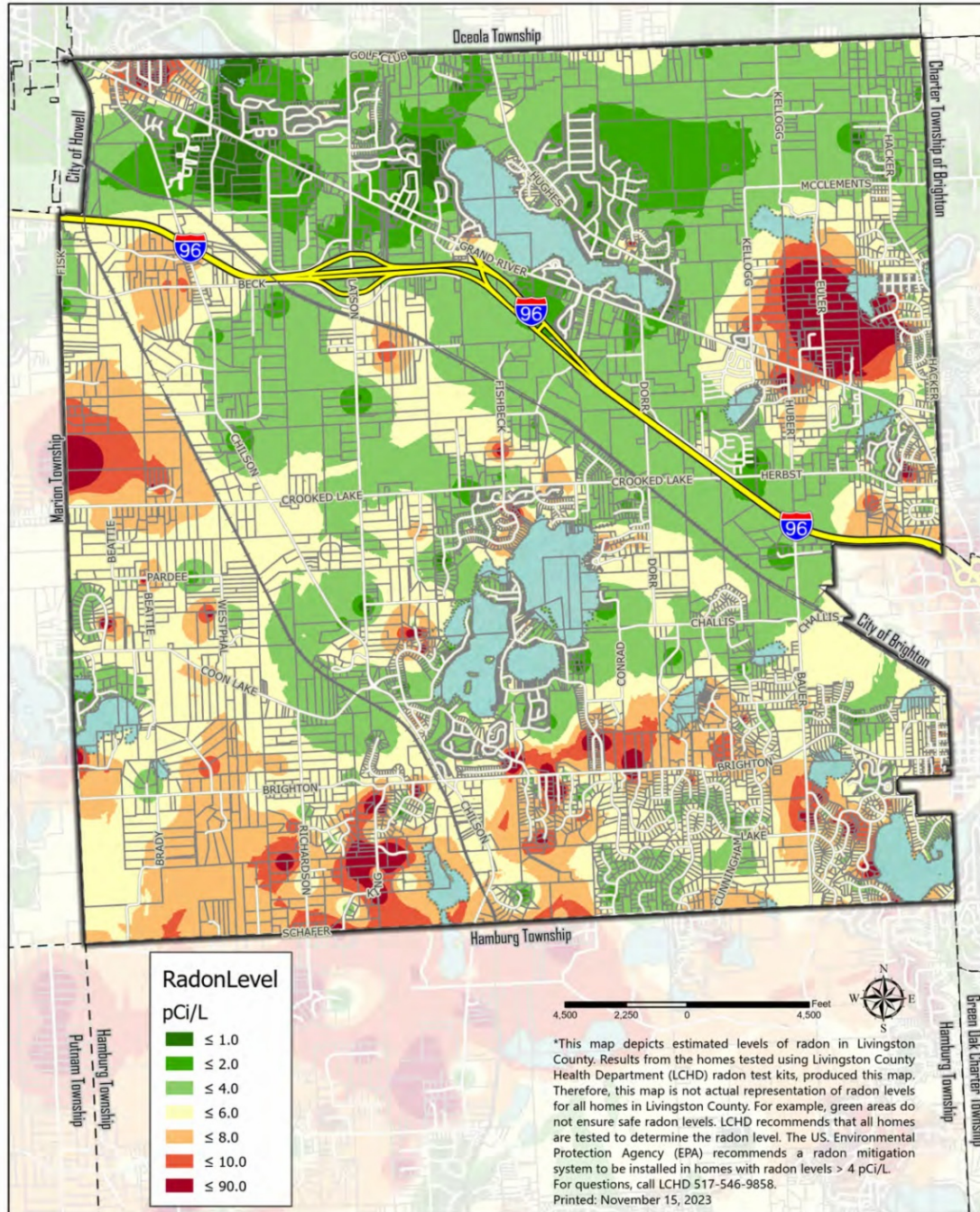
- Waste Management will take one bulk item from every household every week.
- These are items that do not fit in your garbage cart. Examples furniture, TVs, washing machines, etc.
- Excess garbage bags or recycling is not bulk.
- Fabric items must be completely wrapped in plastic.
- Bulk should be placed out the night before your collection day, about 3 feet from your garbage cart.
- Bulk items are collected by a special truck and must stay at the curb. Collection can take

up to five days. If no pickup after five days, call the Township. We will contact WM on your behalf.

- Waste Management's Christmas tree collection begins the week of January 1 and concludes the week of January 15. Trees should be placed curbside, cut into segments of six feet or less, free of decorations and unbagged.
