Welcome to this month's edition of Genoa Township news via email. Here's what's coming up in the Township:

Summer Tax Information

The 2025 Summer taxes were due on 9-15-25. Summer taxes can still be paid at the Township with additional interest now due. If you're not sure if your summer taxes have been paid please check the Township website at www.genoa.org or contact the Treasurer's office at 810-227-5225.

The 2025 Winter taxes will be mailed out to all property owners on Monday, December 1, 2025. The Winter Tax due date is usually February 28th. The 28th is a Saturday, so taxes will be due Monday March 2,2026. Please contact the Treasurer's office if you do not receive your bill.

Genoa Township / Brighton Senior Center Voucher Program

Effective Date: September 15, 2025

What is Covered: The full \$25 cost of a new Basic membership to the Brighton Senior Center

- Residents can choose to cover any additional fees to upgrade to a Silver or Gold level membership if they so choose.
- There are no reimbursements for memberships that have already paid for this year, however, if the program is extended next year, residents will be able to get a voucher for a renewal at that time.

How It Works: Residents must first come to the Clerk's Counter at the Genoa Township Hall 2911 Dorr Road, Brighton, MI 48116 to verify residency, please bring a picture ID. Once verified, you will be given a voucher to take to the Brighton Senior Center, 125 S. Church St., Brighton, MI 48116. They will then sign you up for a membership and collect the voucher.

2025 Fall Yard Waste Drop off

Our Fall Yard Waste Collection program has been scheduled for the following dates at the Genoa Charter Township Hall from 8 am to 11 am:

Residents may bring their yard waste to the Township Hall Parking lot on this date. Branches and similar materials must be in 3 foot long bundles.

Drop Off Your Unused Prescription Medication and Sharps at the Big Red Barrel

The Livingston County Community Alliance (LCCA) will be hosting a "Big Red Barrel" medication and sharps drop-off event at the Township Hall during the November 1st fall yard waste collection event. This is a free service. No questions asked.

When: Saturday, November 1st from 8:00am to 11:00am

Where: Genoa Township Hall, 2911 Dorr Road, Brighton, MI 48116

What: Unused or expired prescription medications and sharps/sharps containers

How: Put pills in a zip lock container, they can be mixed together. They prefer not to have the medicine container. Keep liquid medications separate. Dump into a zip lock bag with enough paper towel to soak up the liquid. Needles must be the proper disposal container, either purchased from a pharmacy or use a heavy-duty plastic container (i.e. laundry detergent or bleach bottle). Reseal the bottle and tape it.

Do your part to keep medications from being abused. Do not flush unused medication.

Help for Livingston County veterans

Livingston County Veteran Services (LCVS) offers a variety of programs and services to assist veterans and their families. LCVS employs nationally accredited Veteran Service Officers to assist veterans in filing for US Dept. of Veterans Affairs benefits. Honorably Discharged veterans registered with LCVS, and their spouse may utilize complimentary LCVS transportation to medical appointments within a 50-mile radius. To schedule a ride, call LETS at (517) 546-6600, select option 3 and mention veteran status. LCVS offers Honorably Discharged veterans who are less fortunate several assistance programs provided by Emergency Relief funds, such as:

- \$200 food and toiletry voucher plus an additional \$50 for each child in the household.
- \$200 clothing vouchers for their school-aged children up to age 18,
- \$50 Speedway fuel only cards; and
- Dental assistance of up to \$1,000 via LCVS partnership with VINA Dental.

Call (517) 546-6338 to set up an appointment and qualify for these programs.
