Greetings

Welcome to this month's edition of Genoa Township news via email. Here's what's coming up in the Township:

Christmas Tree Collection

Waste Management (WM) tree collection will start Christmas tree curbside collection on Friday, January 2 and end the service on Friday, January 16. Below are the guidelines for set-out.

- WM will collect natural trees only.
- All trees taller than six feet must be cut in half.
- Trees must be free of decorations and unbagged.
- Holiday trees do not count as bulk and may be set out alongside the one item permitted weekly. Scheduling is not required.

CPR/AED training offered at the Township

The Township will host a CPR/AED training class in the Boardroom of the Township Hall at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, January 26.

The class is expected to last 3-4 hours. Class size is limited to 30 people. Township residents will be first priority.

Tax Information

The 2025 Summer taxes were due on September 15, 2025. Summer taxes can still be paid at the Township with additional interest now due. If you're not sure if your summer taxes have been paid please check the Township website at www.genoa.org or contact the Treasurer's office at 810-227-5225.

The 2025 Winter taxes were mailed out to all property owners on Wednesday, November 26, 2025. The Winter Tax due date is usually February 28th. The 28th is a Saturday, so taxes will be due Monday March 2, 2026. Please contact the Treasurer's office if you do not receive your bill.

Genoa Township / Brighton Senior Center Voucher Program

What is Covered: The full \$25 cost of a new Basic membership to the Brighton Senior Center

- Residents can choose to cover any additional fees to upgrade to a Silver or Gold level membership if they so choose.
- There are no reimbursements for memberships that have already paid for this year, however, if the program is extended next year, residents will be able to get a voucher for a renewal at that time.

How It Works: Residents must first come to the Clerk's Counter at the Genoa Township Hall 2911 Dorr Road, Brighton, MI 48116 to verify residency, please bring a picture ID. Once verified, you will be given a voucher to take to the Brighton Senior Center, 125 S. Church St., Brighton, MI 48116. They will then sign you up for a membership and collect the voucher.

Help for Livingston County veterans

Livingston County Veteran Services (LCVS) offers a variety of programs and services to assist veterans and their families. LCVS employs nationally accredited Veteran Service Officers to assist veterans in filing for US Dept. of Veterans Affairs benefits. Honorably Discharged veterans registered with LCVS, and their spouse may utilize complimentary LCVS transportation to medical appointments within a 50-mile radius. To schedule a ride, call LETS at (517) 546-6600, select option 3 and mention veteran status. LCVS offers Honorably Discharged veterans who are less fortunate several assistance programs provided by Emergency Relief funds, such as:

- \$200 food and toiletry voucher plus an additional \$50 for each child in the household,
- \$200 clothing vouchers for their school-aged children up to age 18,
- \$50 Speedway fuel only cards; and
- Dental assistance of up to \$1,000 via LCVS partnership with VINA Dental.

Winter Sledding at the Township Park

When snow is in the forecast come enjoy the fresh snowfall at the Genoa Township sled hill!

The sled hill has a vertical drop of approximately 40-feet and a run length of over 200 feet and is fun for all ages.


Benches have been installed at the top for parents and those waiting to sled. There are heated bathrooms and a warming area at the Township Park Pavilion. There is a parking lot across the Township driveway from the sled hill where parents can sit and watch their sledders in the comfort of their vehicles. Last but not least, a light pole has been installed at the hill allows night time sledding.
