Welcome to this month's edition of Genoa Township news via email. Here's what's coming up in the Township:

### CPR/AED training offered at the Township

Free CPR/AED training will be offered April 27, 2026 as part of Genoa Township's Citizen Enrichment Training.

The training, conducted by the Livingston County Sheriff Department, will be held in the Boardroom beginning at 6 p.m. on that date. It is expected to last between 3-4 hours. Infant/Child CPR techniques will be included in the course. CPR Certificates are available for residents who complete the course. Please indicate whether you plan to obtain the certificate when you register.

The maximum class size is 30 people and preference will be given to Township residents. The Township hall is located at 2911 Dorr Road, Brighton, 48114.

### Spring Yard Waste Drop-offs at the Township Hall

Our Spring Yard Waste Collection program has been scheduled for the following dates at the Genoa Charter Township Hall from 8 am to 11 am:

- Saturday May 9
- Saturday June 6

Residents may bring their yard waste to the Township Hall Parking lot. Yard waste eligible for collection includes brush, bundled branches, grass clippings, leaves, plant debris, prunings and twigs, shrubbery, and vegetable or garden debris. Branches and similar materials must be in 3 foot long bundles.

**Please no plastic bags.**

## 2026 Election Information

The Township will be holding 3 elections in 2026:

- **May 5<sup>th</sup> Special Election – Brighton Area Schools Bond Proposal.** This election is for residents in **BRIGHTON AREA SCHOOLS ONLY** (Precincts 4 & 5).
- August 4<sup>th</sup> – State-Wide Primary Election
- November 3<sup>rd</sup> – State-Wide General Election

### **May 5, 2026, Special Election - Brighton Area Schools District Bond Proposal**

Voters in Precincts 4 and 5 of Genoa Charter Township will vote on the proposed bond at the May 5th Special Election. Voting will commence at 7:00 a.m. and end at 8:00 p.m. All voters in line at 8:00 p.m. will be allowed to cast their vote.

## Help for Livingston County veterans

Livingston County Veteran Services (LCVS) offers a variety of programs and services to assist veterans and their families. LCVS employs nationally accredited Veteran Service Officers to assist veterans in filing for US Dept. of Veterans Affairs benefits. Honorably Discharged veterans registered with LCVS, and their spouse may utilize complimentary

LCVS transportation to medical appointments within a 50-mile radius. To schedule a ride, call LETS at (517) 546-6600, select option 3 and mention veteran status. LCVS offers Honorably Discharged veterans who are less fortunate several assistance programs provided by Emergency Relief funds, such as:

- \$200 food and toiletry voucher plus an additional \$50 for each child in the household,
- \$200 clothing vouchers for their school-aged children up to age 18,
- \$50 Speedway fuel only cards; and
- Dental assistance of up to \$1,000 via LCVS partnership with VINA Dental.
