

## DESCRIPTION

Cor. of Sec. 13; thence bearing N.00°03'10" W. 81.68 feet; thence N.23°41'00" W. 204.63 feet; thence to a curve to the left of Radius 1173.42 feet, A = 44°05'00" a distance of 902.45 feet; thence N.67°26'00" W. 1345.08 feet; thence S.00°18'30" E. 3003.39 feet; thence S.87°22'46" E. 224.18 feet; thence N.1°10'49" E. 495.15 feet; thence S.89°38'58" E. 1543.70 feet to the place of Beginning.
